The OCBA has partnered with the Community Action Partnership of Orange County's Food Bank to help provide relief to those in need.

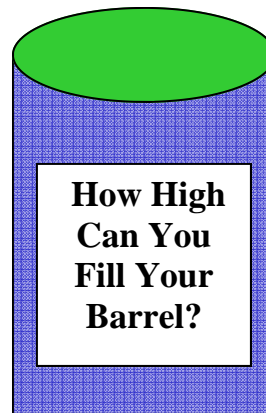
Over 450,000 Orange County residents are at risk of hunger EVERY MONTH.
