L.A. Superior Court Judges Convene Diversity Summit

All attorneys considering a career on the bench can learn the ins and outs of California's judicial application process at a free morning seminar on Saturday, April 11, 2015, hosted by the jurists' Diversity Committee of the Los Angeles Superior Court. The event begins at 8 a.m.

The Judicial Diversity Summit panelists include a gubernatorial senior advisor, representatives from the Commission on Judicial Nominees Evaluation and the Los Angeles County Bar Association, who will convene in the Presiding Judge's Courtroom, second floor, room 222, Stanley Mosk Courthouse, 111 N. Hill St., Los Angeles.

They will share their insights into the judicial application and appointment process and discuss their role in judicial vetting. Josh Groban, senior advisor to the Governor of California, will be among the experts.

A panel of newly appointed judges will divulge their experiences during their early months on the bench.

Small group discussions will follow the formal presentations that include 30 recently appointed judges, former Judicial Nominees Evaluation commissioners and former members of an LACBA judicial application committee.
