<u>Newport Beach</u> – The Orange County Bar Association will present the Harmon G. Scoville Award posthumously to attorney Boo J. Giuffre. This award is presented annually to honor a member of the Orange County legal community whose career exemplifies the highest standards of the legal profession and who has significantly contributed to the Orange County Bar Association and championed our constitutional system of justice.
