Ethical Issues in Bankruptcy Representation

The panel will discuss the ethical duties and obligations of Chapter 7 Debtor's counsel as raised in the case of *In Re Seare* when unbundling legal services in California, and potential new bankruptcy local rules on the topic. The panel will also discuss the new opinion by the State Bar of California Standing Committee on Professional Responsibility and Conduct regarding the simultaneous representation of a Chapter 7 Debtor in a simple no asset case and the Debtor's creditors. Practical advice on how to comply with these new ethical concerns will be provided.
