Northwestern Football – Is Unionization in the Playbook?

Litigation currently pending before the National Labor Relations Board will determine whether football players at Northwestern University are entitled to the protection of the National Labor Relations Act in their efforts to unionize. This talk will explain the issues and arguments in the Northwestern football players' case and will explore what might happen if the players succeed in unionizing.

- What form would collective bargaining between universities and athletes take?
- Will unionized teams at private universities compete against public university teams in states that prohibit college athletes from bargaining collectively?
- What is the relationship between the push to unionize at Northwestern and the antitrust challenges to NCAA rules governing scholarship athletes?
- Will recognizing some college athletes as employees entitled to unionize affect college sports that do not generate revenue?
