	PLC's Health Law Unit provides compassionate direct legal representation, in addition to coordinating and supervising pro bono representation in the following areas: public benefits, insurance coverage, medical billing disputes, disability rights, probate, end-of-life planning and other related issues for low-income families dealing with health-related issues in and near Orange County. The Unit also operates PLC's AIDS Legal Assistance Project, providing civil legal assistance for people living with HIV/AIDS.
