- Admission to practice law in California (or, at least one U.S. jurisdiction),
- 1-5 years of experience practicing immigration law (recent law graduates are welcome to apply),
- Fluency in a second language (e.g., Spanish or Vietnamese); and
- Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a fast-paced, evolving environment.

The ideal candidate will also demonstrate:

- Ability and willingness to work at a law school campus, directly with the Clinic team, including law students enrolled in the clinic;
- Experience with, demonstrated commitment to, and cultural competency for working within a diverse client and student community; and,
- A sense of humor, positive attitude, and self-awareness.
