Based on the recommendations by the California Department of Public Health, and in alignment with the efforts of other organizations across the state, OCTLA has decided it safest to make changes to our upcoming calendar:

April 15 - Breakfast Round Table Meeting - This event is cancelled.

April 23 - Bad Faith MCLE Seminar at Tustin Ranch Golf Club - For the time being, this event remains on our schedule. We will provide an update as this date approaches.

April 28 - CAOC's Annual Justice Day - We are waiting to hear from CAOC regarding the status of Justice Day. In the meantime, OCTLA would advise any potential attendees to please ensure you protect your flight/hotel costs in case the event is cancelled. We will provide notice of CAOC's final decision regarding this event when we have it.

May 1-2 - CAOIE/OCTLA Palm Springs Seminar - For the time being, this program does remain on calendar. OCTLA would advise any potential attendees to please ensure you protect your travel/hotel costs in case the event is cancelled. We will provide timely notice of any changes to the scheduling of this event.

This is uncharted territory for our organization, and we are doing the best we can to serve our members, while still protecting them against public health concerns.
