J-1 Waiver and an Overview of Nonimmigrant and Immigrant Options for International Medical Graduates

J-1 Waiver and an Overview of Nonimmigrant and Immigrant options for International Medical Graduates: Physicians who have participated in a program to receive graduate medical education or training in the U.S. often have a two-year home-country physical presence requirement. This panel will address the process for obtaining a J-1 waiver through the Conrad 30 and DHHS programs, O-1 visas, as well as immigrant visa options for physicians.

This program is an interactive Zoom meeting. Participants will be allowed to unmute and activate their video. Registered attendees will receive the Zoom registration link from the OCBA the day before the meeting.
