***Husky Int’l Electronics v. Ritz - What You Need To Know
 About the Landmark U.S. Supreme Court Decision***

The panelists will discuss the potential impact of the recent U.S. Supreme Court case of *Husky Int’l Electronics v. Ritz*, which could drastically change the types of claims that might be determined non-dischargeable. The case holds that “misrepresentation” and “reliance” are not necessary elements of an actual fraud claim under 11 U.S.C. Section 523(a)(2). More importantly the Court's interpretation that a debt “incurred by” fraud does not have a temporal component has even more far reaching potential consequences.
