Justice Murray will lead an interactive discussion of the new procedures for objecting to peremptory challenges. These new procedures go into effect in all criminal cases on January 1, 2022, and in civil cases on January 1, 2026. In addition to earning 1 hour of CLE for elimination of bias, attendees will gain a practical understanding of the new procedures for objecting to the improper use of peremptory challenges and how actual and implicit bias can and do impact jury selection in all cases.



Justice Murray is well-known for his insightful and inspiring educational programs, as well as his leadership on criminal law and jury selection issues. In 2020, Justice Murray served on the Judicial Council's Criminal Law Advisory Committee and chaired the A.B. 3070 (Batson/ Wheeler Reform) Working Group Subcommittee.
