The Racial Justice Act (RJA) is codified in Penal Code sections 745(a)-(j). It went into effect in 2021. 745(a) states: "The state shall not seek or obtain a criminal conviction or seek, obtain, or impose a sentence on the basis of race, ethnicity, or national origin."
